## Venn: Powerful and High-Level and Set Manipulating ... a whole new way of working with data

Native R does not provide great tools for working with set. Some funcitons, like subset and split exist, but these can become tedious, overly verbose and error-prone especially with high-dimensional data. The venn package alleviates the frustration of working sets. The venn packages provides: a simple R-like mechanism for defining sets, all the usual set functions (union, interesection, complement, etc.), high-level syntax and semantics, simple partioning, straight-forward segmentaion, the ability to work abstractly and apply the results to new data, and the ability to apply functions to regions of data that is very difficult using the \*apply alone. Depending on how you look at it, venn is either a tool to make working with sets possible and easy OR a whole new way of working with data.
